

Bamboos we grow at Trees by Touliatos

There are about 1200 species of Bamboo that are living on this planet, and we grow and sell seven of them. They range in height from 15 feet to about 70 feet, and are Evergreen in a normal to mild Winter. While some bamboos tolerate shade, most want sun. Many people are afraid of using Bamboo due to its spreading nature. Spreading Bamboos are like humans in that they grow where they are rewarded, and fail to do so where they are punished. To be successful with Bamboo it must be contained in some way. Buildings, standing water, and wide driveways will work in most situations.
